

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240360

Center North Sixteenth corner located in Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

From the following evidence of the location described below, set a 1 x 36 ins. galvanized iron pipe, 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. brass cap marked:

Original bearing trees marked by Howard and Rhodes in 1913 for Alex Martin Tract found in field book "J", page 30:

- White Oak, 7 ins. diam. with an opened single face with axed "X" and nail in the center, brs. Record: S11¾°E, 32.50 feet to face. Re-measured 33.00 feet to center at base.
- White Oak, 8 ins. diam., with single healed blaze brs. Record: N48½°E, 20.60 feet to estimated face. Re-measured 20.75 feet to center at base. **Note:** Record called for Black Oaks.

Corner lies S72½°E, 6½ feet from fence corner with fence lines projecting N-E and W.
