

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340300

Quarter corner common to Sections 21, 28, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, WM $V=21^\circ$

Found 6 x 6 ins. concrete pedestal, projecting 12 ins. with embedded $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins. brass cap marked:

U.S. ENGINEER DEPARTMENT
Portland District
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Boundary Monument

From which:

- Pine fragments were found at location of original N.E. BT, as recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854.
- **Note:** Records relating to the establishment of the above monument, to date, have not been located.

To perpetuate the position of said monument I marked the following trees "CSRP" in upper blaze, "BT" in lower blaze and take measurements to center of tree at lower blaze:

- A Black Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears $N50^\circ E$, 25.45 feet.
- A White Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears $S21\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 17.3 feet.

The corner of a North and East-West bearing fence line (an 18 ns. diam. White Oak) lies approximately $S30^\circ W$, 7.5 feet.
