

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400240

Quarter corner common to Sections 27 and 28, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M. $V = 19\frac{3}{4}^\circ$

Found original N.E. BT marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854, now a Laurel, 12 ins. diam., containing scribed "BT" in exposed lower face.

At record bearing and distance $N58^\circ E$, 10.56 feet from scribed face, I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 29 ins. in the ground with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. bronze disc marked:

C.S.
1973

I mound stones around corner marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears $S70^\circ E$, 37.8 feet.
- A White Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears $S42^\circ W$, 74.7ft.

Corner lies 4.5 feet West of North-South fence line.
