

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400300

Corner to Sections 21, 22, 27, 28, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found a 6x6x? inch concrete monument with 3½" bronze disc marked boundary monument for the corner, the original bearing tree to Northwest intact, the bearing tree to northeast with scribe visible, remains of bearing tree to southeast, also down, pine tree with scribe visible to southwest.

From said monument for corner:

- The original bearing tree, a 24" White Oak intact, bears N38½°W, 276.5 feet.
- Scribed a 10" White Oak C.S.-BT which bears N4°E 85.5 feet.
- Scribed an 8" White Oak which bears S58°E, 37.5 feet.
- Scribed a 9" White Oak C.S.-BT which bears S70°W, 232.7 feet.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400300

Section corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Found projecting 7 ins., the 6x6x? concrete monument with 3½ ins. diam. center punched bronze cap as recorded on first re-establishment, in 1945.

Original bearing trees marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854 found:

- White Oak, now a 20 ins. diam. snag with rotted lower face, brs. Record: N36°E, 199.32 feet on slope to said face.
- White Oak, now 33 ins. diam. with double healed blazes, brs. Record: N38°W, 277.60 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; 275.88 feet to face.

Bearing trees marked on first re-establishment:

- White Oak, now 14 ins. diam. with double healed blazes, brs. N4½°E, 85.65 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; N4°E, 85.5 feet.
- White Oak, now 16 ins. diam. with opened upper and healed lower blaze, brs. S57°E, 37.80 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; S58°E, 37.5 feet.
- White Oak, now 12 ins. diam. with double healed blazes, brs. S70¼°W, 233.45 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; S70°W, 232.7 feet.

Corner lies in an opening 2.0 feet North and 11.0 feet East of a corner post to fences bearing East, West and South.
