

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400340

Quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 22, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, WM $V=20^\circ$

From the following evidence and at the location described below, I set a 1x36 ins. G.I. pipe 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

T36S R1E
¼S
21 | 22
Jackson County 1974

Original BTs marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854 found as follows:

- The base of a down and rotted Oak, bears record, S10°E, 79.2 feet.
- A White Oak snag, 16 ins. diam., with rotted upper face, containing scribed "BT" in opened lower face, bears record, S15°W, 70.62 feet to scribed face.

I mound stones around corner, marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A Ponderosa Pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N59°E, 57.2 feet.
- A White Oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N36°W, 32.3 feet.

Corner lies 57 feet East of North-South fence line.
