

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 400640

Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found both original bearing trees.

Set 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 16" in the ground with 2½" brass cap stamped:

T36S R1E  
¼ 4 | 3 cor.  
C.S.  
1968

From which:

- The original bearing tree, now an 18" pine stump, badly decayed, with "BT" scribe bears North  $32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West, 99.7 feet to the center of the stump.
- The original bearing tree, now a 26" White Oak hollow snag bears North  $67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East, 98.4 feet to the center of the snag.
- An 11" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North  $58\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  East, 14.2 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- An 8" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North  $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  West, 39.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
