

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 440600

Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 10, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found a stake in a mound of stone for the corner and set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T36SR1E
3
¼S — COR
10
C.S.
1967

From which:

- A 20" White Oak with both faces chopped out and a chip with relief of chain notch and probable portion of relief scribe. Said tree bears North 72° East, 61.4 feet to the old face, (Vic Gardner reports seeing a chip with legible scribe at this tree about 3 years ago);
- A yellow Pine stump with outside eroded bears South 25½° West, 96.3 feet to the center of the tree.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 10" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears South 30½° West, 62.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 14" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears North 61° East, 46.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
