

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500540

Quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 11 Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Found old stake in a mound of stone for corner.

Replaced said stake with a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with bronze cap stamped:

T.36 S. R.1 E.
¼ 10 | 11 Cor.
C.S.
1970

Set 30" in the ground for corner, from which:

- Found earth depression that agrees for location of the original bearing tree (N77°E, 43 feet);
- Found a 17" White Oak, scribed "¼ S" by Surveyor Elksnat approximately 70 years ago which bears N83°E, 44.9 feet to the face of the upper blaze (Elksnat Record = 14" White Oak, N83°E, 44.9 feet).
- Found an 8" White Oak, scribed "BT" by surveyor Elksnat approximately 70 years ago which bears S36°W, 19.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze (Elksnat Record = 7" White Oak, S36°W, 19.8 feet).
- Scribed a 10" White Oak, "CS-BT" which bears S36°E, 36.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- Scribed a 12" White Oak, "CS-BT" which bears S71½°W, 23.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
