

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT
QUARTER CORNER TO SECTION 2 ONLY
GCDB 540700

North quarter corner to Sections 2, Township 36 South, Range 1 East - on the 8th Standard Parallel South.

Set a 1"x36" galvanized iron pipe, 34 ins. in the ground with 2½" brass cap stamped:

T35-36S, R1E

From which:

- The original bearing tree, now a badly decayed 24" Fir stump with "BT" scribe bears North 24° East, 154.1 feet to the center of the stump.
- An 11" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 21½° West, 13.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 13" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 88¼° West, 25.4 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- The center of Lick Creek bears East, 57 feet.
