

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600500

Corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found a ½" iron pin in a mound of stone for the corner. Directly over said pin, set a 1"x36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T36S R1E

From which:

- The original Black Oak, plainly scribed, now 20", bears North 52° East, 40.0 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- The original White Oak now 12" with blazes intact bears South 71½° West, 53.9 feet to the center of the tree;
- The original White Oak now 14" with blazes intact, bears North 35½° West, 29.7 feet to the center of the tree;
- The original White Oak, now 20" with blazes intact, bears South 87½° East, 40.7 feet to the center of the tree;
