

**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT
CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 1 AND 2 ONLY
GCDB 600700**

Corner common to Sections 1 and 2, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, on the 8th Standard Parallel South.

Set 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 34" in the ground with 2½" brass cap stamped:

T35-36S, R1E

From which:

- The original bearing tree, now a 16" White Oak snag, with "BT" scribe bears South 9½° West, 69.3 feet, to the face of the lower blaze.
- At record bearing and distance to Southeast I find a 6" White Oak growing out of a stool of old White Oak
- A 10" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears South 5¼°E, 53.2 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 28" Yellow Pine scribed "CS-BT" bears South 84½°E, 193.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 6" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears South 75½°W, 21.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 6" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 33½°W, 55.7 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
