

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640200

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found an 18" White Oak to the Northeast, opened the lower blaze and exposed the BT scribe.  
Also found a White Oak snag to the Southeast with scribe visible.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T36S, R1E  
25  
¼S — c.s.  
cor 36  
1964

From which;

- The original bearing tree (now an 18" White Oak) bears North 31° East, 10.6 feet;
- The White oak snag bears South 84° East, 161.7 feet.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- A 12" White oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 3¼° East, 58.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 6" White oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 66° West, 18.7 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
