

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640500

Quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found a 7" x 9" x ? sandstone, with large cross, set along the southwesterly side of a yew wood anchor post, from which the stump of a large Black Oak with BT scribe intact under 12" of overgrowth (record White Oak) bears South 60° West, 210.3 feet (record South 60° West, 211.2).

This is on a slight slope and natural distance would be very close to record. In absence of the other tree and since this stone has been the recognized corner for many years, it was considered to be the true corner.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 14" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears North 6° West, 116.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 14" Black Oak scribed CS-BT bears North 27½° East, 253.2 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- All bearings are individual magnetic bearings since the corner can not be occupied.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640500

Quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Found a sandstone, 14x10x8 ins. with 8 ins. cross on top, as reported on first re-establishment in 1967. Replace stone with and lay alongside a 1 x 36 ins. galvanized iron pipe, 33 ins. in the ground with 2½ ins. brass cap marked:

From which brs.:

- Single remaining original BT recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, an Oak stump 37 ins. diam., with negative impression scribe marks, S60°W, 209.38 feet to face. Record 211.2 feet.

Bearing trees marked on first re-establishment found:

- White Oak, now 17 ins. diam., N6°W, 117.45 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: 116.5 feet.
- Black Oak, now 20 ins. diam., N27½°E, 253.46 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: 253.2 feet.

Corner lies 0.5 feet Southwest of fence corner post. Fence course South and East.
