

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640600

Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 12, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, WM  $V = 19\frac{1}{2}^\circ$

Found remains of an old Pine post in a mound of stones.

I replaced said post with a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe set 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Original BTs marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854 found as follows:

- The remains of a Pine stump bears record, N10°E, 7.92 feet.
- The stump remains with decayed Black Oak section alongside containing chain notch and partial scribed "BT", bears record, S21°W, 42.9 feet on slope.

I marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of tree at lower blaze:

- A Ponderosa Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S38½°W, 66.5 feet.
- A White Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears N64½°W, 36.4 feet.
