

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700540

Quarter corner common to Section 12, Township 36 South, Range 1 East and Section 7, Township 36 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T36S, R1-2E  
¼ 12 | 7 Cor.  
C.S.  
1972

From which:

- The original Southeast bearing tree, now a 14" Black Oak with healed faces bears S37¾°E, 40.7 feet to the center. (original record: 10" Black Oak S38°E, 40.26 feet)
- The original Southwest bearing tree, now a Black Oak stump with "¼S" scribe visible bears S66°W, 10.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze. (Original record: 16" Black Oak S66°W, 10.56 feet)
- An 18" Cedar scribed "CS-BT" bears S56¼°E, 30.2 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 12" Black Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears S45°W, 51.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
