

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700640

Quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 6, Township 36 South, Range 1 and 2 East, W.M.
 $V = 21^\circ$

Found, original N.W. BT marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854, a White Oak (on N-S fence line) now 21 ins. diam., scribed "BT" in opened lower face. No evidence of original N.E. BT found.

At record bearing and distance, $N78^\circ W$, 17.82 feet from scribed face, I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 29 ins. in the ground with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. bronze disc marked:

R1E $\frac{1}{4}$ S R2E

Jackson County 1974

I marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Oak, 10 ins. diam., bears $S51\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 61.0 feet.
- A White Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears $N10^\circ W$, 86.6 feet.
