

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

DLC41SW

GCDB 806200

Southwest corner of D.L.C. No. 41, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Set 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 30" in the ground with 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T.36S. R.1E.
S.W. | D.L.C.
Cor. | 41
C.S.
1969

From which:

- The original bearing tree, (now an 18" White Oak with blazes left intact) bears S25°W, 88.1 feet to the center of the tree;
- The original bearing tree, (now a 13" White Oak, plainly scribed) bears S68°E, 55.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- The original bearing tree, (now a 16" White Oak with blazes left intact) bears N87°E, 55.5 feet to the center of the tree;
- A 9" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears N10°E, 67.2 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
