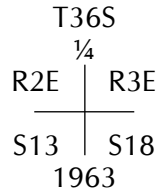


FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100440

Quarter corner common to Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 2 East and Section 18, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found a standard BLM brass cap flush with the ground, marked:



From which:

The single remaining reference marked by the BLM in 1963 found:

- Douglas Fir, 17 ins. diam. (noted as a White Fir by the BLM), with a single healed blaze, bears record N42½°W, 29.25 feet to the center of tree at base. Record distance; 29.04 feet.

Take new references as follows:

- Chiseled an "X" on a 5x3x2 feet boulder which brs. S60¼°E, 21.10 feet to the center of "X".
- White Fir, 4 ins. diam. scribed "CS BT" brs. S43°W, 52.88 feet to the center of tree at lower blaze.
- White Fir, 20 ins. diam. scribed "CS BT" brs. S77¼°W, 37.54 feet to the center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on the West edge of a dirt road course North-South.
