

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200200

Section corner common to Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.
V = 20°30'

Found stone as recorded, 24 x 10 x 6 ins. marked with 1 notch on the South and 5 notches on the East edge, firmly set.

Replaced stone with a 1 in. x 36 ins. G.I. pipe set 18 ins. in the ground marked:

From which:

- A 23 ins. Black Oak (Orig. BT) with scribing visible bears S44½°W, 83.35 feet to center of tree. Record: S43°W, 82.50 feet.

New trees marked C.S. BT and measured to center of tree:

- A 13 ins. Black Oak, bears N77°E, 42.90 feet.
- A 5 ins. White Oak, bears S11°W, 6.3 feet.
- Set stone alongside.

Lead and tack set in a drill hole in the top S.W. corner of a 7 feet x 4 feet. Rock outcropping exosed 4 feet, bears N21½°W, 38.21 feet.
