

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200400

Section corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

At the corner, found projecting 9 ins., the 2 ins. diam. pipe with standard BLM brass cap marked:

T36S R3E	
S18	S17
1956	

As recorded in 1956.

Original bearing trees marked by R. Moore in 1883 and reported by the BLM in 1956, found as follows:

- White Fir, 36 ins. diam., with healed blazes, bears N30°E, 36.70 feet to center. Record: N32°E, 37.62 feet.
- White Fir, 51 ins. diam., with healed blazes, bears S62°E, 41.7 feet to center. Record: S63°E, 40.92 feet.
- White Fir, 41 ins. diam., with partially (re) healed upper face, bears N38°W, 27.2 feet to center. Record: 25.74 feet.

A bearing tree marked in 1956 by the BLM found:

- White Fir, 48 ins. diam. with healed single blaze, bears S76°W, 45.8 feet to center. Record: S76½°W, 46.20 feet.

Mk. a new tree "CS" "BT":

- White Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S88¾°E, 22.2 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on West slope about 500 feet East of stream C. North-South.
