

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240200

Quarter corner common to Sections 29 and 32, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.
V = 20°30'E

Found basalt stone as per record, 22 x 12 x 6 ins. with "¼" on upper side as the stone was tipped out. Also found both original BTs.

Set 1 in. x 36 ins. G.I. Pipe flush with the ground marked:

T3 S R E

1973

From which:

- The two original BTs with healed blazed still in good condition bear as follows:
- A 32 ins. Cedar, bears N20°E, 26.56 feet. Record: N18°E, 38.28 feet fits on slope dist.
- A 24 ins. Cedar, bears S16°E, 43.56 feet. Record: S20°E, 43.56 feet.

Did not remark trees, set stone alongside as memorial.
