

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240600

Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M. V = 20°

Found the original basalt stone, 8 x 10 x 12 ins., firmly set and marked with "¼" on the North side as recorded by R. Moore in 1883.

I replaced said stone with a 1 in. x 36 ins. G.I. pipe set 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

From which:

- The stump hole of the original N.E. BT bears record N40°E, 19.14 feet.
- A burnt Cedar snag, 36 ins. diam., with numerous axe (cruiser symbols) marked, bears S20°W, 31.3 feet.

I marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A S. Pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N36°W, 38.4 feet.
- A Fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S64½°W, 23.3 feet.

Original stone deposited alongside as memorial to corner.

Corner lies at intersection of N and E-W blazed lines approximately 65 feet North of location marker alongside logging road.
