

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### ANGLE POINT

GCDB 343700

Angle Point, (old  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner), common to Section 33, Township 35 South, Range 3 East, and Section 4, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.  $V = 19\frac{1}{2}^\circ$

Found, bearing tree recorded by R. Moore in 1883, now a Fir stump shell about 14 ins. diam., with axed face, scribed "BT".

From the preceding evidence:

I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 28 ins. in a found mound of stone with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1975  
T35S R3E  
S 33  
A.P.  
S 4  
T36S

From which:

- The above-described BT, bears record  $N25^\circ W$ , 2.64 feet to scribed face.
- All original trees now gone.

I marked new trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears  $N38^\circ E$ , 14.35 feet.
- Cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears  $S60\frac{1}{2}^\circ W$ , 23.20 feet.

Corner lies about 900 feet West of location marker on 6 ins. diam. Douglas Fir, alongside road.
