

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

ANGLE POINT

GCDB 403700

Angle Point between Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 3 East, and Section 3, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M. $V=21^\circ$, 59.4 feet East of C.C. 4 and 3 (T36S).

Found, the single remaining original BT recorded by N. Ford in 1855 and noted by R. Moore in 1883, now a down and rotted Fir about 20 ins. diam., containing scribe marks in rotted and burned face.

From the preceding evidence:

I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 34 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

T36S

I marked new trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Douglas Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears $N28\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 16.35 feet.
- Douglas Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears $S62^\circ W$, 12.14 feet.
- The closing corner of Section 3 and 4, bears $N88\frac{1}{2}^\circ W$, 59.4 feet See first re-establishment, dated 1950.

The base of a down and rotted Yew, about 12 ins. diam., containing scribe marks in exposed face, bears (computed) record $S65^\circ W$, 38.3 feet. See index J, Book A-1, page 155.

Corner lies about 225 feet East of location marker on 20 ins. diam. Fir, alongside road.

Found, 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1975
T35S R3E
S 34
A.P.
S 3
T36S

From which found references noted on 1975 re-estab:

- Douglas Fir, 16 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. N 30° E, 16.35 ft; Record, N 28½° E to center of tree at base.
- Douglas Fir, 19 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. Record S 62° W, 12.14 ft. to center of tree at base.
- The closing corner of Section 3 and 4, brs. Record N88½°W, 59.4 ft.

Corner lies on SE'ly ascending slope, in wooded area, approximately 60 ft. South of logging road.
