

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### ANGLE POINT

GCDB 613700

Angle Point between Section 36, Township 35 South, Range 3 East and Section 1, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.  $V = 20^\circ$

Found, the only remaining BT recorded by N. Ford, in 1855, (also noted by R. Moore in 1883) a Yellow Pine, now 46 ins. diam., containing partial scribed "2" and backwards "S" in opened upper face.

From the preceding evidence I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 32 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1975  
T35S R3E  
S 36  
A.P.  
S 1  
T36S

From which the above original BT bears record,  $S55^\circ W$ , 91.74 feet to scribed face.

I marked new trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Ponderosa Pine, 9 ins. diam., bears  $S61^\circ E$ , 26.17 feet.
- Ponderosa Pine, 19 ins. diam., bears  $N58^\circ W$ , 49.25 feet.

Corner lies about 60 feet East of jeep road.
