

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640500

Quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 36 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 7 ins. in a mound of stones, the 2½ ins. diam. galv. iron pipe with a 3½ ins. diam. brass cap set by the BLM in 1962, marked:

T36S R3E  
S12

S13

Bearing trees recorded by the BLM in 1962 found with healed single blazes and measured to center at base:

- D. fir high-stump 18 ins. diam. brs. record; N7°W, 11.2 ft.
- D. fir, now 23 ins. diam. brs. record; S56°E, 19.5 ft.

Mark new bearing trees "CS" "BT" and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- D. fir 9 ins. diam. brs. N56°W, 22.4 ft.
- D. fir 9 ins. diam. brs. S75½°W, 34.1 ft.
- No trees of size in northeast quadrant due to clear-cut.

Corner lies approx. 700 ft. east of dirt road.
