

SPECIAL CORNER

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100340

Quarter corner common to Section 19, Township 36 South, Range 4 West and Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Found the ½ ins. diam. iron pipe protruding 5 ins. above the ground in a small mound of stone with 2 ins. diam. metal cap marked:

T36S
¼ Cor
R5W 24 | 19 R4W
1968
505

Set in 1968 on Survey No. 3850, by proportionate method.

A 5/8 ins. diam. iron pin protruding 11 ins. above the ground in mound of stone found on Survey No. 3850, but of unknown origin, brs. S26°W, 8.6 feet distance.

To perpetuate this location, mark new trees "CS" "BT" and measure to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 4 ins. diam., brs. N40½°E, 35.7 feet
- Madrone, 6 ins. diam., brs. N27°W, 22.2 feet.

Corner lies on gentle South slope on North-South brushed line and approximately 240 feet North of irrigation canal.
