

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100540

Quarter corner to Sections 12 and 7 Twp. 36S, Range 4 & 5 West.

At the corner point I found a 2 inch diam., by 3 feet high Douglas Fir post in small mound of stone from which original BT:

- Black oak, 20 ins. diam., bears N16°E, 42.5 feet dist., scribe visible, blaze opened.
- Black oak, 15 ins. diam., bears S36°W, 64.2 feet dist., blaze healed, scribe negative visible.

And a BT per BLM in 1964:

- Incense cedar, 12 ins. diam. bears S32°E, 15.0 feet dist., blaze healed.

At the corner point I set a 2 ins. G.I. pipe and Brass cap marked:
