

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

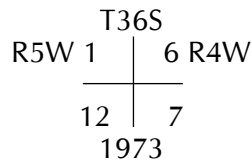
GCDB 100600

Section corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 36 South, Range 4 West and Sections 1 and 12, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

At the corner point I found a 4 inch diam. by 3 feet high oak post set in mound of rock from which original BTs:

- Ponderosa pine, 26 ins. diam., bears N29°E, 26 feet dist., scribe visible, blaze opened.
- Black oak dead and down bears S29°W, 18.2 feet dist. scribe visible.

At the corner point I set a 2 inch G.I. pipe with brass cap marked:



From which new BT:

- Douglas fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S31°W, 7.5 feet, marked "CS S12 R5W BT".
- Douglas fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S88°E, 27.6 feet dist., marked "CS S6 R4W BT".
- Black oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N75°W, 15.0 feet dist., marked "CS S1 R5W BT".
