

SPECIAL CORNER

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240500

Quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 17, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Found the 1½ ins. diam. iron pipe set by proportionate measurement on Survey No. 1834 dated 1961, protruding 6 ins. above mound of stone. Set yellow plastic cap marked "Jackson C.S." in top of found pipe in cement.

Bearing trees marked on Survey No. 1834 found:

- Douglas Fir, 19 ins. diam. with healed single blaze brs. S67¼°E, 43.29 feet (record 43.56 feet.) to center of tree at base.
- Black Oak, 8 ins. diam. with healed single blaze, brs. Record: N28¾°W, 42.9 feet to center of tree at base.

To perpetuate this location, take a new reference:

- Douglas Fir, 5 ins. diam., marked "CS" "BT", brs. S69°W, 9.7 feet to center of tree at base.

Corner lies on 55% South slope n rocky area.
