

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300400

Corner to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian.

Found original BTs to Southeast and Southwest in poor condition, with scribe visible; also stump hole of BT to Northeast.

Set a 2"x36" galvanized pipe 24" in the ground for corner; which checks record distance and course from BTs to Southeast and Northeast.

- BT to Southwest checks for course; distance shows 44.5 feet, record calls for 48.84
- Scribe a 14" White Oak which bears North 17° East, 150.2 feet;
- Scribe a 24" White Oak CS-BT which bears South 34½° East, 115.0 feet;
- A 1" pipe found to mark the corner bears North 16° East, 3.4 feet.

## SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300400

Section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

At the corner, found projecting 5 ins. from mound of stone, the 2 ins. diam. galvanized iron pipe set on First re-establishment, page 6, in 1935. In the top of said pipe in cement, set a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap, marked:

Bearing trees marked on First re-establishment, found with healed blazes and re-measured as follows:

- White Oak, 20 ins. diam. brs. Record: N17°E, 150.2 feet to estimated face. Re-measured; N17°E, 150.72 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
- White Oak, 26 ins. diam., brs. S34°40'E, 115.24 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; S34½°E, 115.0 feet.

The base and Root hole of an original bearing tree recorded by Ives & Hyde in 1854, a down and rotted Oak, about 12 ins. diam., brs. as recorded in 1935, S48°W, 44.5 feet.

- The 1 in. diam. pipe noted on First re-establishment is found projecting 10 ins. and brs. N13°30'E, 3.45 feet. Record; N16°E, 3.4 feet.

Bearing trees of unknown origin, with healed single blazes found and measured to center of trees at base:

- Black Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. West, 9.0 feet.
- White Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. N70°45'W, 8.0 feet.

Mk a new tree "CS" "BT":

- Black Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. S58°10'E, 5.15 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies about 300 feet West of location marker on 3 ins. diam. Pine located alongside irrigation canal C. East, near the Northwest corner of trailer park.
