

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340100

Quarter corner common to Section 33, Township 36 South, and Section 4, Township 37 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Found projecting 4 inches the 2-inch diameter iron pipe, set on Survey No. 3604, in 1967.

In top of said pipe set a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

Original bearing trees recorded by Ives and Hyde, in 1854, and reported on Survey No. 3604 found:

- Black Oak, 18-inch diameter with healed blazes, bears Record: N73°W, 33.66 feet to estimated lower face. Re-measured 33.95 feet to center.
- Black Oak shell, 24-inch diameter, with chaining notch and scribe mark "T", bears S4°W, 18.48 feet to face. Record: S4°E.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of tree at lower blaze:

- Ponderosa Pine, 19-inch diameter, bears N8°W, 25.08 feet.
- Ponderosa Pine, 16-inch diameter, bears S89°E, 31.72 feet.

Corner lies on a 28% East slope.
