

**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT**

**GCDB 500500**

Section corner common to Section 10, 11, 14, and 15, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

At the corner, found projecting 1 in., the 1 in. diam. iron pipe set on Survey No. 2629, dated 1964. In the top of said pipe in cement, set 2½ ins. diam. brass cap marked:

Bearing trees marked on Survey 2629 found with healed blazes and measured to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. N77°E, 48.42 feet. Record: 49.30 feet.
- White Oak, 13 ins. diam., brs. S14°W, 49.45 feet. Record: 13°13'W.
- White Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. N65°W, 29.21 feet. Record: N64°30'W, 29.50 feet.

Marked a new tree "CS" "BT":

- Ponderosa Pine, 11 ins. diam., brs. S34°30'E, 78.19 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies 26.5 feet, S8°E, from location marker on 4 ins. diam. White Oak, alongside road, C. North and East.
