

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500640

Quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 3, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Set a 1"x36" galvanized iron pipe 34" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T.36S. R.4W.
¼ 3 | 2 cor.
C.S.
1971

For corner, from which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 21" Black Oak with scribe visible) bears S5°W, 58.1 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- The original bearing tree (now a 16" Black oak with healed blazes) bears N13°E, 13.1 feet to the center.

Establish new bearing trees as follows:

- A 14" Douglas Fir, scribed "CS-BT" bears S26¼°E, 59.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 12" Yellow Pine, scribed "CS-BT" bears N53½°W, 37.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
