

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700240

Quarter corner common to Section 25, Township 36 South, Range 4 West and Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.  $V = 24^\circ$

From the following evidence, at the location described below, I set a 1x36 ins. G.I. pipe 28 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1975

¼S  
25 | 30  
R4W R3W

Original BTs recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, found as follows:

- White Oak, 15 ins. diam., with healed blazes, bears record S53°E, 8.58 feet to estimated upper face. Re-measured, 9.08 feet to center.
- White Oak, scribed "¼S" in exposed upper face, bears record S50°W, 3.30 feet to estimated lower face.

I marked a new tree C.S. BT:

- White Oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N89°E, 50.45 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies about 50 feet North of ravine, C. S60°W.

The center of tailings, South of mine tunnel, bears N78°E, 64.5 feet.
