Found Oak stake for corner, also original BT to Southeast and Southwest.

Set 1½"x36" galvanized iron pipe for corner, from original BTs.

- The original BT bears South 82° West, 63.36 feet.
- A 14" Yellow Pine scribed CS-BT bears North 84°50' East, 26.7 feet;
- A 20" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears North 36°40' West, 165.0 feet.

## SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

The Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 37, located in Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Found 2 ins. deep and badly mushroomed, the 1½ ins. diam. iron pipe re-reported set on first re-establishment, page 5, in 1927.

Replaced said pipe with, and deposit it alongside of, a 1x36 ins. galvanized iron pipe set 34 ins. in the ground. In the top of now pipe, set in concrete, a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap marked:

Original bearing trees marked by Sewell Truax in 1855 found:

- White Oak, now a 32 ins. diam. 10 feet tall stump with double partially healed blazes visible, brs. S48°E, 33.20 feet to center of tree at root crown. Record: S44°E, 32.34 feet to face.
- White Oak, now 26 ins. diam. with a single healed blaze visible, brs. Record: S82°W, 63.57 feet to center of tree at root crown. Record distance; 63.36 feet to face.

Bearing trees marked on first re-establishment found:

- Yellow Pine, now 30 ins. diam. with double healed blazes, brs. N86¾°E, 27.06 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: N84°50'E 26.7 feet to face.
- White Oak, now 22 ins. diam. with double healed blazes, brs. N36¾°W, 165.81 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: N36°40'W, 165.0 feet to face.

Corner lies in an open area, 2.0 feet North of a wire fence bearing N50°E, 29 feet Easterly from the intersection of this fence and wire fences bearing South and West, and approximately 100 feet North of a draw, course Northwest.
