

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

Interior Ell corner to Donation Land Claim No. 41, located in Section 27, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Found 20 ins. deep, the monument (wagon axle) reported on Survey No. 6281, in 1976. For diagram and dimensions of said monument see 1984 Jackson County Field Notes, page 38.

To perpetuate this location, directly over the center of found axle, set a 1x14 ins. galvanized iron pipe, 6 ins. deep, in pasture, with yellow plastic cap marked:

JACKSON CO.

C.S.

From which: a found 5/8 ins. diam. rebar, being the Easterly right of way of Birdseye Creek Road, station 7 + 98.36, per Survey No. 8491, brs. N37°36'W, 654.75 feet.

Set 5/8 x 24 ins. rebars, with yellow plastic caps flush:

- N25°33'E, 127.22 feet located 2 feet South of fence line, c. N50°W.
- S25°33'W, 201.87 feet.

A Black Oak, 30 ins. diam. with healed double blazes (no record) brs. S25°33'W, 214.21 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
