

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

East Southeast corner to Donation Land Claim No. 43, Twp. 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.
V = 17°

Found, ½ ins. diam., G.I. pipe, reported on Survey No. 2958, dated 1966, at the corner of North and West bearing fence lines.

- The only remaining original BT, a White Oak, now 19 ins. diam., with exposed, rotted face, bears N37°E, 50.5 feet to estimated face. Record, N37°E, 50.82 feet.

I marked new trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 7 ins. diam., bears N77½°E, 23.40 feet.
- White Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears S10°E, 2.50 feet.
- White Oak, 4 ins. diam., bears N47½°W, 16.60 feet.

Corner lies at top of North bank, 15 feet North of small stream and about 50 feet North of the center of Miller Gulch Road.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

East Southeast corner Donation Land Claim No. 43, located in Section 25, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Found the ½ ins. diam. pipe reported on first re-establishment, dated 1976.

Replace said pipe with and lay it alongside a 1x36 ins. galvanized iron pipe, set 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap marked:

T36S R4W

The single remaining original bearing tree,

- A white oak reported on first re-establishment, now 21 ins. diam., brs. N37°E, 50.57 feet to estimated face. Re-measured 51.03 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record (1976); 50.5 feet to estimated face.

Bearing trees marked on first re-establishment found with healed blazes and measured to center of tree(s) at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 8 ins. diam., brs. Record: N77½°E, 23.43 feet.
- White Oak, 9 ins. diam., brs. S10°E, 2.39 feet. Record: 2.50 feet.
- White Oak, 6 ins. diam., brs. N47½°W, 16.40 feet. Record: 16.60 feet

Note: A 1 ins. diam. iron pipe, found 1 feet deep, brs. S59°E, 1.55 feet. Said pipe believed to be that recorded set by Osgood and Cummings on "Amended Plat of Riverside Subdivision, dated 1911.

Corner lies at top of the North bank of and 15 feet North of the middle of small stream and about 50 feet North of the middle of Miller Gulch Road.
