

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### GCDB 100100

Township corner common to Section 36, Township 38 South, Range 2 West, Section 1, Township 39 South, Range 2 West, Section 31, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, and Section 6, Township 39 South, Range 1 West, W.M.  $V = 18^\circ$

Found 3-inch diameter black iron pipe projecting 9 inches with 3½-inch diameter standard GLO brass cap marked:

By M. S. Wright in 1917 retracement.

Original bearing trees marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854 and noted in resurveys in 1883 by R. Moore and 1917 by M. Wright, are found as follows:

- Ponderosa Pine (noted in 1883 as a Fir), now 19-inch diameter with scribe marks visible in open upper face, bears  $S14^\circ W$ , 35.2 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: (1854, 1883)  $S10^\circ W$ , 36.96 feet. Record: (1917)  $S14^\circ W$ , 34.98 feet.
- Easterly branch, 13-inch diameter of a double Douglas Fir, with scribe marks visible in open upper face, bears  $N57^\circ W$ , 18.6 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: (1854, 1883)  $N62^\circ W$ , 16.50 feet. Record: (1917)  $N57^\circ W$ , 18.48 feet.
- Bearing trees marked by R. S. Moore and noted by M.S. Wright now a Douglas Fir stump, 24-inch diameter, 5 feet high, with healed double blaze bears  $S49^\circ E$ , 34.8 feet to center of tree lower blaze. Record (1883)  $S47^\circ E$ , 42.24 feet. Record: (1917)  $S47^\circ 30' E$ , 34.32 feet.

Bearing tree marked by M.S. Wright is found as follows:

- Douglas Fir stump, 22-inch diameter, with partial healed blaze visible, bears  $N77\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 55.1 feet to center of tree at base. Record:  $N77^\circ E$ , 55.44 feet.

I marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Black Oak, 7-inch diameter, bears  $N18\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 49.3 feet.
- Incense Cedar, 9-inch diameter, bears  $S46\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$ , 50.2 feet.

Corner lies about 150 feet East of location marker on 6-inch diameter, Douglas Fir, alongside road, course-North.
