

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100340

Quarter corner common to Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 1 West and Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found 1½-inch diameter iron pipe protruding 6 inches above ground, set on Survey No. 1702 dated 1960-61.

In top of found pipe, set a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

T38S  
R2W R1W  
¼S  
24 | 19  
C.S.  
1987

Bearing trees marked on Survey No. 1702 found with healed single blazes and measured to center at base:

- Black Oak, 10-inch diameter, bears N55°½'E, 12.40 feet, record 12.54 feet.
- Douglas Fir, 18-inch diameter, bears Record: N40°½'W, 37.62 feet.

Marked new references:

- Power pole bears N84°08'W, 19.20 feet to center.
- Metal post 2-inch diameter of West and North (5 feet extension) cyclone fence bears S80°11'W, 14.20 feet.

Corner is located 2 feet South of E-W page-wire fence line and approximately 185 feet North of location marker on a 12-inch diameter Madrone on North side of Griffin Creek Road.
