

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 140200

One quarter corner common to Sections 30 and 31, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Set 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T38S R1W
30
¼S — Cor.
31
C.S.
1969

From which:

- The original Southwest bearing tree, now a sawed Fir stump plainly scribed "BT", bears S72°W, 39.6 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- Laurel trees growing out of an old Laurel stool check record location of the original Northwest bearing tree.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new bearing trees to wit:

- A 7" Fir, scribed "CS-BT", bears S76¼°W, 23.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 11" Fir, scribed "CS-BT", bears N32¼°W, 54.7 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
