

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200140

Quarter corner common to Sections 31 and 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found both original bearing trees.

For corner set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T38S, R1W  
¼ 31 | 32 cor.  
1966

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 23" Yellow Pine, plainly scribed "¼S"), bears S35°W, 38.9 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- The original bearing tree (now a 24" White Oak snag badly rotted), bears N38¼°E, 30.8 feet to the lower face.

From said pipe corner, I established the following new witness trees:

- Scribed a 6" White Oak "CS-BT" which bears N64°E, 38.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
- Scribed a 10" Black Oak "CS-BT" which bears N21¼°W, 16.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
