

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300340

Quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 21, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found 6 inches deep, the $\frac{5}{8}$ -inch diameter iron pin set on Survey No. 5133, dated 1973.

To perpetuate this position, over the top of said pin, set a 1 x 36-inch Galvanized iron pipe, 30 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

Marked new trees "CS BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White Oak, 9-inch diameter, bears S12°45'E, 39.50 feet.
- White Oak, 10-inch diameter, bears N79°20'W, 36.05 feet.

Corner lies about 19 feet North of gravel driveway and 2.5 feet, N45°E, of wood post corner of North and East-West bearing fence line.
