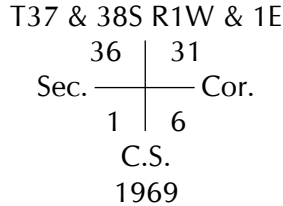


FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700700

Township corner common to Townships 37 and 38 South, Range 1 West and 1 East, W.M.

Set 1"x 36" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:



From which,

- The original bearing tree, (now a 34" Black Oak snag, plainly scribed) bears S37½°E, 398.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze;

Found no evidence of the original Northeast bearing tree. From said pipe corner, I establish the following new bearing trees:

- A 21" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears N41¼°W, 37.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 15" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears N88¼°E, 51.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 6" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears S24½°W, 39.1 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- A 24" Twin Black Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears S44½°E, 106.1 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
