

PROPORTIONED CORNER – NO FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT
DLC42SE

The Southeast corner of DLC #42, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

No evidence of original corner.

Set 2" gas pipe 48" long, 42" in the ground for corner on single proportionate distance on line between SW corner DLC #42 and NE corner DLC #43.

Most Easterly NE corner of DLC #42 bears $N0^{\circ}05'W$, 981.8 feet.

Southeast corner to DLC No. 42, located in Section 15, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found flush in ring of stone, 3-inch diameter brass cap in concrete marked:

T38S R1W

Note: First Re-establishment* in 1927, record a 2-inch diameter gas pipe set at the proportionate position of corner. The only recovered record of the above-noted brass cap is found in field book entitled "RECONNAISSANCE NOTES": Copy of information relative to this corner is attached to 1985 Jackson County Field Notes, page 123.

To perpetuate this location, take new references:

- Iron (I-5 right-of-way) pin found flush at corner of R/W and East bearing fence lines, bears West, 434.84 feet.
- Set 5/8 x 24-inch rebar, 23 inches in the ground with yellow plastic cap marked "Jackson C.S.", on South slope, bears S2°35'E, 9.65 feet.
- The base of 3½ inches, outside diameter iron pipe; the Southwesterly support of highway sign:

"Exit 24"
Phoenix
1 mile

Bears S68°03'W, 395.29 feet.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- The Westerly branch, 14-inch diameter of a double White Oak, bears N48°42'36"E, 287.25 feet.
- White Oak, 14-inch diameter bears N2°34'49"W, 398.05 feet.

Corner lies on East-West fence line, an estimated 360 feet West of foot of Westerly slope of hill.
