

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

DLC47SW

GCDB 847130

Re-establishment of the SW corner DLC #47, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

- Found the 3" x 8" x 16" sandstone scribed C 47 setting alongside of the remains of an old yew wood anchor post.
- Set a 1½" x 25" galvanized iron pipe directly underneath the said stone as found.
- Chiseled a cross in top of the said sand for corner.

From which:

- The Southwest corner of a 4' x 4' concrete siphon outlet (irrigation) bears N45°E, 12.1 feet.
- The center of a 20" sour apple tree bears S58°W, 34.3 feet.
- The center of an 8" pear tree bears N64°W, 32.1 feet.
- The center of an 8" pear tree bears S1½°E, 18.1 feet.

**SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT**

**DLC47SW**

**GCDB 847130**

Southwest corner to DLC No. 47, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

At the corner, found 18 inches deep, the 1½-inch diameter iron pipe, set on First Re-establishment in 1947.

Directly over found pipe is found the apparent, original 3 x 8 x 13-inch stone marked "47" by S. Truax circa 1856 and reported in 1947.

A portion of the top appears to be broken off and was not found.

In the top of the above noted pipe, set a 1 x 12-inch galvanized iron pipe, 7 inches deep, with a 2½-inch diameter bronze cap marked:

The single remaining reference noted in 1947, a pear tree, now 21-inch diameter, bears N63°35'W, 32.15 feet to center, at base. Record: N64°W, 32.1 feet.

Deposit found stone alongside corner and take new references:

- Pear tree, 15-inch diameter, bears N45°08'E, 33.75 feet to center.
- Pear tree, 15-inch diameter, bears S59°51'E, 36.55 feet to center.
- Pear tree, 10-inch diameter, bears S59°34'W, 34.62 feet to center.
- A 6-inch diameter water valve, bears N14°42'E, 62.08 feet.

The peak of roof, over the Westerly end of house, atop small knoll an estimated 2,417 feet distant, bears S78°40'35"E. The peak of roof, over the Northerly end of house and estimated 1,366 feet distant, bears S14°40'42"E.

The (brass cap) WNW corner of DLC #47 bears North 1327.01 feet.

Corner lies about 10 feet East of the intersection of orchard roads c. North-South and East-West.
