- Iron pipe, 2-inch diameter, projecting 5 feet, bears N23°58'E, 8.80 feet to center at base.
- Ash, 5-inch diameter (not scribed) bears N50°W, 2.95 feet to center of tree at base.

Corner lies in blackberry bushes at the intersection of South (board) and East-West (page wire) fences, in the (Northeast corner) back yard of residence 202 North First Street (Talent).
