

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

DLC81NNW

North Northwest corner of DLC #81, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, also being the NE DLC #82, Township 38 South, Range 1 West.

Found the original witness tree to the Northeast with two old axe faces, but scribing rotted away.

From which set:

- A 1"x 20" iron bolt for corner.

From which:

- Scribe a 20" Black Oak CS-BT which bears N44½°E, 52.7 feet;
- Scribe a 20" Black Oak CS-BT which bears N31°W, 119.0 feet;
- The center of an 8" Peach tree bears S3½°W, 20.7 feet;
- A 1¼" x 1" "U" bar at the Northeast corner of DLC #81 bears S89¼°E, 860.7 feet.

Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim No. 82, being also the North Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 81, located in Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found 2 inches deep in concrete surrounded by stones, a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

T38S R1W  
DLC  
NE  
Cor 82  
C.S.  
1971

Bearing trees marked on First Re-establishment, page 32, in 1956 found with double healed blazes and measured to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Black Oak, now 26-inch diameter, bears N44°E, 53.4 feet. Record: N44½°E, 52.7 feet.
- Black Oak, now 27-inch diameter, bears Record: N31°E, 119.51 feet. Record distance: 119.0 feet.
- An unmarked location poster on a wooden fence post bears S33°E, 3.7 feet.

Corner lies in a large opening, 3.4 feet North of an East-West fence.
