

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

WaterLot1_SCor

The South corner of Water Lot No. 1 in the village (now town) of Phoenix, Oregon.

For explanation of the evidence and methods used in re-establishing this corner, see Survey No. 317, Jackson County Survey Records.

Also further evidence for the location of the corner was obtained from several longtime residents.

Set a 2 x 40-inch iron pin for corner.

From which:

- A lead slug in a concrete sidewalk bears N38°00'W, 30.00 feet.
- A punch mark in the center of an iron bolt at the base sign column bears S52°50'E, 12.29 feet.
- The intersection of the center lines of First Street and Pacific Highway bears N82°31'W, 42.46 feet.
- A 1-inch iron pipe, recently set, bears Northwesterly 0.91 feet.
