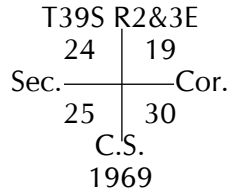


FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100300

Section corner common to Sections 24 and 25, Township 39 South, Range 2 East and Sections 19 and 30, Township 39 South, Range 3 East.

Set 1"x36" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:



From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 12" Black Oak, down and dead, plainly scribed) bears S80°W, 100.6 feet to the center of the stump hole.
- The original bearing tree, (now a 20" twin Black Oak, with healed blazes) bears N76°E, 38.0 feet to the center. Record: N84°E, 38.0 feet to the center.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new bearing trees:

- An 8" Black Oak, scribed "CS-BT", bears S19½°E, 18.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- An 8" Black Oak, scribed "CS-BT", bears S84°W, 48.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- A 7" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT", bears N46½°W, 55.4 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
